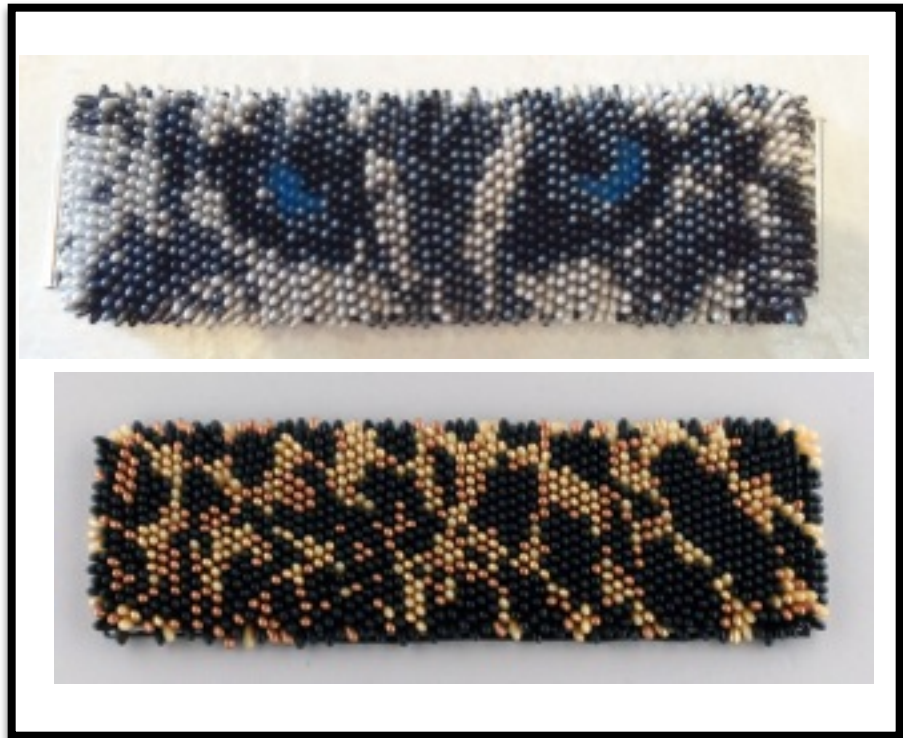

Right Spot (bottom right)

Textured bead embroidery takes this whimsical animal print bracelet to the next dimension. Using pre-printed beading foundation as a guide, embroider Rizos vertically to give the illusion of fur. Students will learn how to read a graph, basic embroidery techniques, how to back and edge it, how to add a clasp.

Level: All Levels welcome

Stitches: bead embroidery

Prerequisite: none

Colorways: leopard, snow leopard, tiger, zebra

India Blue (top)

Learn how to paint a picture with beads with this stunning three dimensional bead embroidered bracelet. Use a variety of Japanese and Czech beads to bring this fabulous peacock to life in all his glory right down to his stately crown. Students will learn how to backstitch, stop stitch and layer and combine many different types of beads to create a variety of effects, They will also learn how to finish a bracelet with blanket stitch edging and add a clasp.

Level: All Levels welcome

Stitches: bead embroidery

Prerequisite: none

Ilien (bottom left)

Explore three-dimensional textured bead embroidery with this elegant tassel encrusted with pearls, crystals and a blend of seed bead shapes, colors and finishes. Cascading strands of decorative chain tipped in crystal teardrops and a pearl netted rope complete this stunning necklace. Students will learn how to construct a three dimensional dome; basic bead embroidery techniques including the back stitch and stop stitch on a printed template; how to construct and embellish a decorative chain tassel; and use wirework techniques to transform it into a pendant. They will also learn how to stitch and finish a netted pearl rope.

Level: Beginner

Stitches: peyote, pearl netting, bead embroidery

Prerequisite: peyote stitch

Kit Fee: \$130.

Colorways: One color way as pictured.
