

Stitch Workshop - Peyote with A Twist (PeyTwist or PWAT) By Kristen Ho - Beaded Treasures by K



Tools Needed:

- 1) Size 12 Beadalon beading needles
- 2) Fire-line beading thread - size 6lb test or your favorite beading thread
- 3) sharp fine scissors to cut the thread
- 4) At least two colors of size 11/0 seed beads - rounds. For learning we will be using rounds.

I will distribute a couple of files.

One will be a historical account of the stitch by Gerlinde Lenz.

One will be a PeyTwist pattern by Tina Hemr.

There are a few ways to join in.

- 1) I will join a swatch of peyote to show you how to start “single seam” PeyTwist.

I will provide homework for you to join in if you’d like to do the “join” with me. This uses 6 colors. This pattern is provided by Gerlinde.

- 2) I will also cover how to read a “formal” PeyTwist pattern. The designer has allowed me to distribute this pattern to you. I will have a swatch of this ready to join too. This pattern uses 3 colors.

We will be doing the following during our April meeting:

- 1) Learn the mechanics of creating the tube.
- 2) The parts of the stitch for each row: the V formation and the “outward” and “inward” stitches.
Covering single seam PeyTwist.
- 3) How to read a PeyTwist pattern.

Future possible meetings might cover:

- 1) When to use single or double seam.
- 2) How to stitch the Mondrian inspired necklace in the photo.
- 3) How to convert a traditional crochet pattern into a PeyTwist pattern.

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
