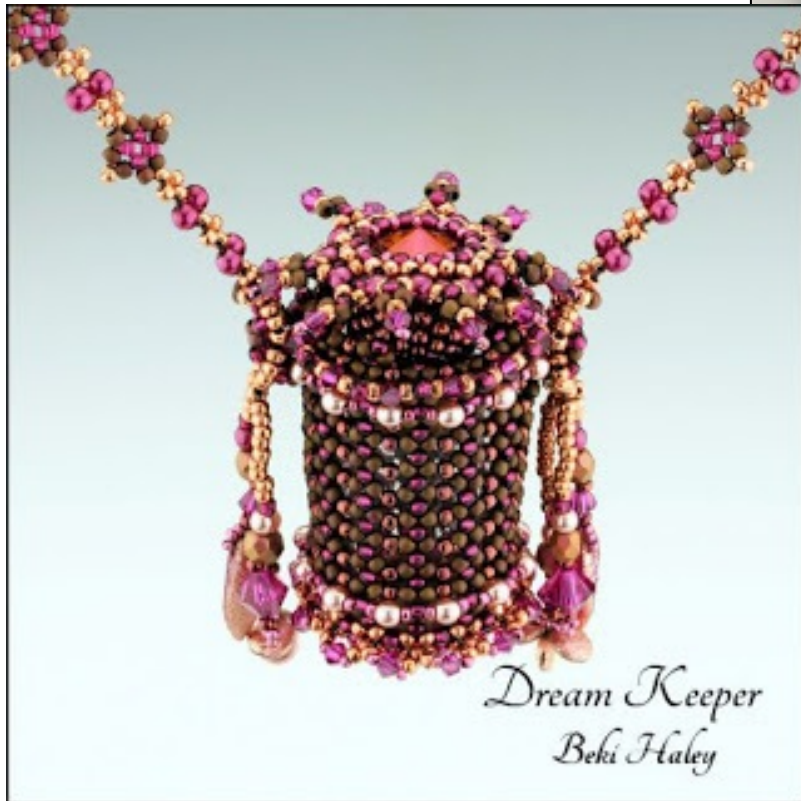


Northern Virginia Bead Society Presents a Virtual Workshop Series with Beki Haley

Requirements for Beki's Classes – PLEASE READ (and not just the summary at the top!)

- **CRAW PROFICIENCY is mandatory for any class where it's in the description! It will NOT be taught in class!**
- **Kits are Mandatory!**
- **Virtual class necessities – make sure they work before the day of the class!**
- **Register early!**
- **Kits and cancellation policy!**
- **Thread recommendations for Beki's classes!**

Details on each of the bullet points are below:

CRAW PROFICIENCY is mandatory for any class where it's in the CLASS DESCRIPTION! It will NOT be taught in class!

You MUST be proficient in CUBIC RIGHT ANGLE WEAVE for Beki's classes. Must. (This means you have *done* CRAW RECENTLY – not just watched a video.) This is a project-oriented class and class time will not be used for tutorials on stitches!

Kits are Mandatory!

Because these are virtual classes where Beki will be unable to look over your shoulder in case you get stuck, kits will be mandatory to make sure all the supplies are the ones that will work for the project.

Virtual class necessities – make sure they work before the day of the class!

To see and participate in the virtual class, you will need to have a working camera and microphone (webcam, tablet, or cellphone). You MAY also wish to have a second camera, either a second webcam or some other arrangement of tablet/cellphone/computer that communicate with each other so you can show your work to Beki in class, should you need to do so.

Register early! NVBS exclusive registration until May 25, 2020!

Registration will be exclusively open to members of NVBS until May 25, 2020. On May 26, 2020 registration will be open to the public. Note: the virtual class size will be lower than if the class were in-person, so if you're interested in these classes, don't wait!

Late registration may mean you don't get your kit in time for the class (due to shipping delays in this "new normal" world). Kit orders should be sent in by June 26th to reasonably expect the kits to arrive before the class dates. You will get further information on how to order kits AFTER YOUR REGISTRATION HAS BEEN PROCESSED.

Kits and cancellation policy!

Beki will not accept kit orders for the class projects unless you are enrolled in the class. No separate instructions for the class projects will be sold, so it's either register for the class and pay for the kit, or wait till Beki can come in person to teach again.

Once your registration has been processed by NVBS, we will send you a kit order form. PLEASE do not expect this to happen immediately. Remember, we are all volunteers and are doing the best we can. It may take up to a week from the time you pay for your class until you receive your kit order form.

Once you receive the form, you will email it to Beki. She will then send your kit on or before July 6th. **ONCE THE KIT HAS BEEN SHIPPED TO YOU, THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR THE CLASS OR THE KIT, NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Thread recommendations for Beki's classes!

If you are a tight beader, you can use 6 lb Fireline or 8 lb Nanofil. If you are NOT a tight beader, Beki recommends using 8 lb Fireline or 10 lb Nanofil. Please do not use a nylon thread (OneG, Nymo, SoNo, etc).

Sabrina (top right) – Friday July 17, 2020 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

Sabrina has a beautifully bezeled Swarovski Navette stone in Embellished CRAW, a Peyote Petaled Pearl Flower and another oldie but goodie from Beki's repertoire of days gone by.... Graduated Spiral Rope. A fun project open for lots of color combination and a skill set in bead weaving techniques that you can apply to many other projects.

Level: Intermediate

Stitches used: peyote, CRAW and spiral rope

Prerequisites: Must be proficient in CRAW, ability to work with 15/0 seed beads is helpful.

Kit: \$78. Color choices: Denim/Steel; Amethyst/Bronze; Purple/Green

Dream Keeper (middle) – Saturday July 18, 2020 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

Create your own special beaded Dream Keeper comprised mostly of Hubble Stitch with a little RAW added in for texture and a change of pace, you will learn how to bezel in Hubble as well as create the tubular body of this vessel. An additional bezel for the lid also has a cute wooden "stopper" attached to help add a little weight to the piece. Toss in some sparkle from some lovely Swarovski Rivoli and you'll have a stunning necklace!

Level: Intermediate/Advanced

Stitches used: Hubble stitch, Modified RAW, Fringing, Embellishing and finishing techniques that will enhance your bead weaving skills.

Prerequisites: Ability to work with 15/0 seed beads is helpful.

Kit: \$75. Color choices: Denim; Purple; Teal

Tuscany (bottom right) – Sunday July 19, 2020 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

Using various colors of seed beads you'll capture sparkling Swarovski stones in Cubic Right Angle Weave that you'll then embellish with crystals, pearls and some of the more uniquely shaped new beads on the market. Then create a beautiful and versatile modified RAW necklace to suspend these elements from.

Level: Intermediate/Advanced

Stitches used: CRAW; Embellishing; Modified Right Angle Weave

Prerequisites: Must be proficient in CRAW

Kit: \$68. Color choices: Astral Pink/Maroon
